

## Ship Corinthian on her Passage to Heard's island

Saturday Sept 27<sup>th</sup>

Begins with a strong gale from the N.W. and hauls to the N. and Moderates took in all sail but a double reef main top sail and fore sail & rain. Struck main top gallant yard and mast so the ship has no other about her top masts aloft. Middle part light airs with rain. Latter part a fresh breeze from the S. pleasant steering S.E. all sail set so ends the 24 hours.

Sunday Sept 28<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the S.W. pleasant and hauls to the N.W. light winds steering S.W. East all sail set hands employed in ship's duty. Middle part the same latter part a fresh breeze from the N.W. reefed the top sails pulled main sail and jib steering S.E. so ends the day.

Monday Sept 29<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.W. pleasant steering S.E. all sail set. Middle and latter part the same steering S.E. so ends.

Tuesday Sept 30<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with a strong breeze from the N.W. pleasant steering S.E. under reefed top sails jib and courses. Middle part the same latter part moderate set all sail set and steering S.E.

Lat by calculation 46:30 Long 48:00

Wednesday October 1<sup>st</sup>

Comes in with a strong breeze from the N.W. thick weather steering S.E. under double reefed top sails. Middle part bore to under a close reef main top sail. Latter part a strong breeze from the N.W. with fog kept off at daylight set double reef top sails steering S.E. Day ends with a thick fog.

Thursday Oct 2<sup>nd</sup>

Comes in with a strong breeze from the N.W. with thick fog steering S.E. under double reef top sails at dark bore to under close reef main top sail heading N.W. Middle part blowing a gale. Latter part the same sailing to so ends the day.
