Comes in with a strong breeze from the N.E.W. pleasant at 1st M kept off S.E. under a close reef. Main top gail and fore sail Middle part Moderate breeze from the N.W. set double reef top sails latter part a fresh breeze from the N.E.W. pleasant steering S by E all sail set so Ends the Day

Saturday Oct 4th

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.E.W. pleasant steering S by E under double reef top sails and fore sails middle part Moderate breeze with squalls of snow latter part a fresh breeze from the N.W. pleasant steering S by E

Lat 50:50 Long 67:34

Sunday October 5th

Comes in with a strong breeze from the N.W. pleasant steering S by E under all sail crew employed in ship's duty middle part a fresh breeze from the N.E.W. latter part Moderate breeze from the N.W. pleasant steering S by E all sail set

Lat 53:37 Long 72:00

Monday October 6th

Commences with a Moderate breeze from the N.E.W. pleasant at 12 o'clock hauled up S.E. carrying all sail at S. steering E. at 3 o'clock to under short sail Heards Islands bearing E.S.E. for compass distance by calculation 30 miles Middle part Moderate sailing to latter part made sail and steered S.E. by E thick weather at 8 coming on to blow a gale took in all sail but a close reef. Main top sail and fore spencer and luffed to Day Ends with a gale from the N.E.W.

Tuesday Oct 7th

Comes in with a gale from the N.E.W. and hauls to the N. Clears up a little saw no Land towards night Moderating broke the Day down to the Harbour boat saved the Boat Middle part blowing a heavy gale latter part gale moderating some set the spencers heading N by E saw Macdonalds rocks were ship heading N.E.W. so Ends the 24 hours

Wednesday October 8th

Comes in with a Moderate gale from the N. pleasant a bad sea on heading N.E.W. under close reef. Main top sail and spencers Middle part blowing a heavy gale latter part more Moderate set fore sail heading N by E carrying heading to the northward
