

Remarks on board Ship Corinthian

Thursday Oct 7th

Comes in with a moderate gale from the N. pleasant Seizing to under close reef Main top sail and Spencers furled the fore sail middle part blowing a gale latter part moderate saw the Seana Steered for it at 10.4 m came to an anchor at Shear Island Moored Ship put two anchors down in 8 fathoms water so Ends

Friday Oct 10th

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the N. pleasant Laying at Shear Island Crew Employed in various jobs middle and latter part the same so Ends the Day

Saturday Oct 11th

Comes in with a gale from the N. with snow squalls Crew Employed in various jobs middle part blowing strong latter part more moderate Employed getting spars ashore and other stuff so Ends the Day

Sunday Oct 12th

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the N. with snow Employed getting spars ashore and tread middle part moderate latter part moderate with rain Employed getting Provisions ashore

Day Ends with pleasant weather

Monday October 13th

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the N. W. with squalls of snow took the spare boats ashore and other stuff middle part blowing heavy from the N. W. latter part the same with some sea on Seizing with three anchors down one four thousand pounds anchor one 3800 and one 2800 with 60 fathoms of chain on each Day Ends with a gale from the N. W.

Tuesday October 14th

Comes in with a gale from the N. with heavy squalls of snow and wind middle part blowing a heavy gale latter part the same to heave to hold communication with the Shore Day Ends with a gale

Wednesday Oct 15th

Comes in with a gale from the N. W. with heavy squalls of snow and wind Laying at anchor with the Brig Doc of New London Capt James Rogers Master middle part more moderate but still blowing heavy latter part moderating fast Employed in various jobs

Thursday Oct 16th

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. W. pleasant Employed in various jobs middle part light air latter part the same Employed clearing anchors so Ends the Day
