up clutter and other jobs
Day ends with a moderate
breeze from the S. W.

Sunday Oct 26th

Begins with a moderate
breeze from the S. W.
pleasant three boats brought
Whittier from the Seepara
hands on board Employed
in various small jobs
so ends the day
