

Ship Corinthian at Heards Island

Monday Oct 27th

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the S.W. with snow squalls throughout the day. Two boats went ashore taking off blubber and other jobs at dark. Moderate from the Northward with a snow storm.

Tuesday Oct 28th

This day comes in with a gale from the S.W. with heavy squalls of snow and wind. Hands employed doing nothing so ends.

Wednesday Oct 29th

This 24 hours comes in with a fresh breeze from the S.W. increased to a gale. Day ends with a gale.

Wednesday Oct 30th

Begins with a gale from the S.W. hauls to the W. and moderate. Day ends with a moderate breeze. Employed getting off blubber and boiling.

Thursday Oct 31st

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the S.W. pleasant. Employed boiling and stowing down and other jobs so ends.

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Friday November 1st

Comes in with a gale from the Eastward with a very bad sea on one coast of ice. Took a drift and stowed it. Lost about 8 barrels of coal at 2 P.M. with a haul to the Northward and cleared up sea. ran down same. Day ends with the same.

Saturday Nov 2nd

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the S.W. pleasant. Employed stowing down and other jobs so ends the day.

Sunday Nov 3rd
Monday

Comes in with a light breeze from the W. with squalls of wind and snow. Employed in various jobs this day airing barge. Pioneer of New Zealand. Morgan Master. Day ends with a fresh breeze from the W.

Tuesday Oct 4

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the W. pleasant. Hands employed in various jobs. Day ends with a light breeze from the S.W. There is now four vessels in here viz. Corinthian, Brig. Joe Pioneer and Laurens.
