Comes in with a moderate breeze from the E with rain all hands Employed on board in various jobs at sundown wind hauled suddenly to the N. and blowed fresh with snow so Ends

Wednesday Oct 12th

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. W. pleasant Cooper Employed setting up Shooks no schooner yet I don't know what's become of her Day Ends with a calm

Thursday Oct 13th

Comes in with a gale from the N. W. with snow squalls though the Day Cooper and his mates Employed setting Pipes Shooks Day Ends with a gale from the N. W. we are the Veil is the schooner
