Saturday Nov 15<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the Eastward with rain till some empty cask ashore on to the Beach on boat and crew came up from Saddle point with a load of blubber and returned again. Day ends with a light breeze from the W. with rain.

Sunday Nov 16<sup>th</sup>

This day comes in with a moderate breeze from the W. with snow squalls. Hands Employed getting blubber and other jobs.

This day arrives Ship Alert  
19<sup>th</sup> Nov. Day ends the with a light breeze from the W. pleasant.

Monday Nov 17<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the Eastward with rain. Very unpleasant weather. Employed doing nothing. Day ends with a light breeze from the SW.

## Ship Corinthian at Heard's Island

Saturday Nov 18<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with a light breeze from the E. with rain. Employed in various jobs.

Sunday Nov 19<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with a strong breeze from the W. pleasant. All hands on board doing nothing. Ends the Day.

Monday Nov 20<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the W. pleasant. Mated with the alert this day. Captain Rogers in company with Captain Church with ten of our men and a part of his went to the Seaward in schooner to land the men for the purpose of skinning Elephant. Day ends with pleasant.

Tuesday December

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the W. pleasant. Hands Employed rafting blubber and other jobs. This day arrived the Alert schooner tender for the Corinthian and the Pacific Captain. Day ends with a fresh breeze from the W.

Wednesday December 2<sup>nd</sup>

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the Eastward with rain. Hands Employed working in and securing blubber middle part and latter part the day. Day ends the Day.
