Comes in with a gale from the W. pleasant. Employed in various jobs Day Ends with a fresh breeze from the W.

Tuesday Dec 30

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the W. N. W. with rain. Employed in various jobs.

Wednesday Dec 31st

Comes in with a fresh gale from the E. with rain. To rig to boil Day Ends More Moderate.

Thursday Dec 1st January 1857

Comes in with a Moderate breeze from the W. pleasant. Started the works and commenced boiling Day Ends pleasant.

Ship Corinthian at Heards Island

Friday January 2nd

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the W. pleasant. Employed boiling so Ends.

Saturday January 3rd

Comes in with a gale from the Eastward with rain. Latter part wind hauls to the W. and blows a gale so Ends.

Sunday Jan 4th

Captain
Shipped 13 of the self old men boiling the atlas returned as foremast hands from the Seward and reports with various says the schooner Alfred ashore to the Seward crew all saved vessel total loss.

Monday Jan 5th

Comes in with a Moderate breeze from the W. pleasant. Employed Stowing down so Ends the Day.

Tuesday Jan 6th

Comes in with a fresh breeze from W. with rain. Employed boiling so Ends this Day.
