

Thursday February 26th 1853

Commences with fresh N
& rain continued the same until
12 M. then the wind changed to
W. NW cleared up Lat part
strong gales from N. W. cloudy
weather so ends

Friday Feb 27th

Commences with fresh gales
NW cloudy weather from 9 AM
to 3 PM winds W & clear
weather then wind shifted to
N. thick weather employed
hooping off with Lat part
fresh gales N. with rain
so ends

Saturday Feb 28th

Commences with fresh gales
from N with at 5 PM wind
NW clear weather at 12 PM
wind W clear at 1 PM
Sawyer got under way for
Lewis setting up 2 hoops
Lat part light winds W & S
so ends

Sunday March 1st 1853

Commences with light winds
from S. S. W. clear weather from
1 PM the off shore anchored
chance put it down more
to N. E. Cooper hooping off
Cask Lat part light winds
from N. N. W. rain so ends

Monday March 2nd

Commences with light winds
from N. N. W. rain at 8 PM
wind NW clear at 12 PM
gales from N. W. clear weather
Lat part fresh gales W & S
clear so ends

Thursday March 12th 1853

Commences with strong gales
from N. W. with squalls of
snow 1 PM wind W clear
at 4 PM wind strong from
with rain & snow at 11 PM
wind W clear so ends

Friday March 13th

Commences with fresh winds
from S. clear weather at 4 PM
Sawyer got under way for Lewis
at 6 PM Cooper hooping off
Sawyer came in
at 8 PM Atlas came in from
Lewis 150 lbs blubber
Lat part calm & rain
so ends

Saturday March 14th

Commences with calm rain
at 6 AM wind from W. cloudy
braking out between decks
putting empty casks ashore and
provisions on board the Atlas
with Sunday other jobs Lat
part light winds N. with rain
so ends

Sunday March 15th

Commences with light winds
N. cloudy a heavy sea heaving in
at 10 AM wind N. W. clear
Sawyer hooping off
2 PM wind W fresh clear
wind NW light with squalls of
snow so ends

Monday March 16th

Commences with light winds
N. S. W. with squalls of snow
at 6 AM wind NW cloudy
at 7 PM Sawyer left for Lewis
Atlas went to saddle point put
cask ashore at 11 PM wind N. W.
hooping off blubber at 11 PM
came in Lat part fresh wind N. W. with rain so ends
