

Tuesday March 17<sup>th</sup> 1857

Commences with fresh winds from NW with rain at 8 AM wind NW clear showing down but I'm fresh gales NW clear last part strong winds NW with squalls of snow so ends

Wednesday March 18<sup>th</sup>

Commences with strong winds NW with squalls of snow at 6 AM calm got a raft of wood from about 10 pikes & bread and a raft of shuck from them took off 3 new whale boats from shore at 10 AM light air from E & N. 5 men went to Saddle Point to winter 12th rain at 3 PM wind NW with rain last part wind & weather the same so ends

Thursday March 19<sup>th</sup>

Commences with strong winds NW with rain at 4 AM stopped raining got a raft of blubber from the shore 5 PM strong gales NW cloudy weather last part light air & variable with rain so ends

Friday March 20<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light air & variable with rain at 6 PM wind NW clear weather light clearing ship & sundry other jobs at 8 PM light air & rain so ends

Saturday March 21<sup>st</sup>

Commences with light winds from E & N with rain at 4 AM wind NW clear weather took a raft of bark ashore took off some blubber & a spar for fish Dory at 1 PM Sawyer came up from Lewis & got blubber last part strong gales NW with squalls of snow so ends

Sunday March 22<sup>nd</sup> 1857

Commences with fresh gales NW with squalls of snow at 5 AM clear wind blowing light blubber Casper & Casper making a fish Dory at 11 AM rain falling Casper with blubber Robinson checks last part wind strong from NW with rain so ends

Monday March 23<sup>rd</sup>

Commences with strong winds NW clear weather April 23rd down but got the rigging clear getting ready for 24th I'm got a raft of water from shore cleared channels & so last part moderate winds NW cloudy so ends

Tuesday March 24<sup>th</sup>

Commences with moderate winds NW cloudy weather light in clearing channels got one anchor on the bow 5 PM strong winds NW clear weather last part light air & passing cloudy so ends

Wednesday March 25<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light winds & thick weather took 2 anchors up one on deck the other on the bow put 5 men ashore to stop through the winter took off a raft of blubber to the Atlas made things secure on deck last part light winds cloudy weather at 4 PM set anchor watches so ends
