Monday April 13th

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the W. N. W. pleasant Carpenter Employed on board the Atlas shanks on board Employed repairing sails Day Ends with a fresh breeze from the N. W. with snow squalls

Tuesday April 14th

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. W. pleasant in the morning afternoon rain hauls to the N. Moderate. Some towards night cleared up wind hauls to the N. W. Ends the Day

Wednesday April 15th

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. W. cloudy weather hands Employed in various jobs schooner & R. Sawyer the man came in to day Day Ends still sick with a from the N. W. N. W.

Thursday April 16th

Comes in with a from the N. W. N. W. pleasant hands on board the Atlas getting her ready for whaling Day Ends with a light air from the N. W.

Friday April 17th

Begins light winds from the water getting the schooner ready & sundry jobs on the ship

Saturday April 18th
All this day light breeze from N. W. & N. E. the Atlas & Sawyer got underway for a cruise employed on board the ship on ship duty

Sunday

Monday April 19th 1857
This day begins with light winds from S. E. & S. South Middle and better part the wind N. East with steady rain

Tuesday April 20th

Continues fresh breeze from N. W. and squalls employed at various jobs Middle part fresh breeze from West and pleasant weather better part light winds from N. East

Wednesday April 21st

Better part light winds from N. West with pleasant weather the Atlas and Sawyer up the bay Middle part huffing winds employed on ships duty better part light winds from N. East

Thursday April 22nd

Begins light winds from N. East with thick fog Middle part pleasant at work setting up sheets repairing sails &c better part fresh breezes from N. West

Friday April 23rd

Comes in light winds from North setting up sheets repairing sails Middle part squally with rain ends moderate the schooner up the bay the still sick

Saturday April 24th

Begins light breezes from N. W. employed on ships duty at 12 M the schooner Atlas and Sawyer come in from Portland Bay with two humpbacks the Atlas came a long way home out the blubber at dark haul off to anchor 20 fms

Sunday April 25th

This day begins light winds from North with fine rain the Atlas hauls along side the ship Middle part the same at work on the schooner ends the same the man still sick
