

Ship Continues of New London Laging Port Harbor. Feb of Revolution to 1857

Sunday May 24th

This day comes in with light breezes from West at 3 am the Atlas got under weigh for Irish Bay at work boiling ends with the same at North with rain

Monday May 25th

Comes in moderate from West at work boiling the wind hauls to West with strong breezes and snow

Tuesday May 26th

Commences calm with snow and fog at work boiling ends light winds from West

Wednesday May 27th

Begins light wind from North with rain at work boiling middle and latter part a fresh gale from West

Thursday May 28th

Comes in a fresh gale from West with snow equally employed in clearing out after hole and other jobs the wind hauls to NW and more moderate at 4 P.M. Sawyer come in with 4 humpbacks

Friday May 29th

Comes in moderate from West at work boiling the wind hauls to NW and pleasant ends calm

Saturday May 30th

All this day light winds from West with steady rain at work boiling

Sunday May 31st

Begins fresh breezes from North with steady rain at work boiling ends the same

Monday June 1st

1857

This day begins with moderate breezes from NW the Sawyer got under weigh for Irish Bay at work boiling at 3 P.M. got through boiling ends pleasant

Tuesday June 2nd

This day begins with the wind from North with heavy rain middle part pleasant from NW employed on ship duty

Wednesday June 3rd

All this day fresh breezes from West at work setting up sheeks and other ships duty the schooners up the bay

Thursday June 4th

Begins with a fresh gale from North with heavy rain middle part the wind hauls to NW with snow equally so ends

Friday June 5th

Comes in fresh breezes from West at work on sheeks getting off water and other ships duty the wind hauls to West and more moderate

Saturday June 6th

Begins fresh breezes from West at work on sheeks and ships duty most required sends the schooners up the bay

Sunday June 7th

All this day light winds from West with snow equally employed on ships duty most required sends

Monday June 8th

Comes in light breezes from West at 4 am the Sawyer come in with two humpbacks and cut em along side the bark ends pleasant

Tuesday June 9th

Begins with light baffling winds and pleasant at 6 am the Sawyer got under weigh for Irish Bay at work on sheeks and other ships duty at 6 P.M. the latter come in with 6 humpbacks

Wednesday June 10th

All this day strong breezes from the Westward put some oil below deck in morning the Atlas and Pacific in the harbor
