Thursday June 11th

This day comes in with light winds from S.W. at 5 am the Atlas and Pacific get under weigh at work boiling

Friday June 12th

Begins a fresh gale from S.W. with hard snow squalls at work boiling middle part more moderate the Pacific in the harbor ends with light winds

Saturday June 13th

Comes in light air from S.West at work boiling the Pacific get under weigh latter part light winds from N.West

Sunday June 14th

All the fore part of this day light winds from North and N.E. with steady rain at work boiling at dark the wind hauled to S.W. and pleasant

Monday June 15th

Begins light winds from S.W. and fine weather employed in boiling ends fresh breezes from N.W. and squally the schooners up the bay

Tuesday June 16th

Commences this day with light breezes from North and N.East with thick fog employed in boiling ends fresh breezes from N.West

Wednesday June 17th

All this day fresh breezes from west and N.W. with snow squalls employed in boiling the Sawyer and Atlas up the bay

Thursday June 18th

This day comes in with fresh breezes from the Westward employed in boiling middle and latter light winds and pleasant

Friday June 19th

Comes in with light winds from S.E. to S.W. heavy rain the latter part pleasant at work at ships duty at 10 P.M. the Pacific comes in

Saturday June 20th

This day begins with light winds from the westward at 8 am the Pacific comes in to anchor employed in boiling the schooners up the bay

Sunday June 21st

Begins fresh breezes S.W. at work on ships duty the Pacific went out and returned again to anchor saw a number of whales from the look out

Monday June 22nd

Comes in moderate breezes from the westward with snow squalls getting off water and other jobs

Tuesday June 23rd

Comes in moderate from S.W. at 6 am the Pacific get under weigh for the second mid part wind hauled to S.W. at 2 P.M. the Atlas and Sawyer come in the Atlas with 4 humpbacks and Sawyer with 3 humpbacks

Wednesday June 24th

Comes in moderate from the westward all hands employed in stowing down the after hole ends with fresh breezes

Thursday June 25th

All this day strong breezes from S.West with plenty of snow squalls employed stowing down the after hole

Friday June 26th

Begins moderate breezes from S.W. employed in stowing down blocked off the after hole ends the wind S.West

Saturday June 27th

Comes in calm with rain at 5 am started the works Middle and latter part a strong gale from S.W. with rain and snow
