All the fore part light winds from N.W. with steady rain and fog ends fresh breeze from west the Atlas up the bay

Saturday July 18th

Begins fresh breezes from N.W. and snow squalls at work on various jobs and steady snow at 11 AM the Sawyer come in with a load of blubber

Sunday July 19th

Come in fresh breezes from N.W. with snow squalls the Sawyer hauls along side the bark and discharged her blubber ends moderate

Monday July 20th

The fore part of this day calm and pleasant at work on the rigging and other jobs at 3 PM the Atlas come in with nothing and light winds from West

Tuesday July 21st

Come in fresh breezes from the Westward repairing the Atlas gill and farsail ends wind N.W.

Wednesday July 22nd

All this day fresh breezes from N.W. at work on various jobs the Atlas and Sawyer in the harbour

Thursday July 23rd

This day begins with breezes from N.W. at work in ships duty the Atlas and Sawyer in the harbour and snow squalls

Friday July 24th

All this day fresh breezes from N.W. with a steady snow storm the Atlas and Sawyer in the harbour

Saturday July 25th

Come in light air from the westward the Sawyer went out all hands employed in repairing ship

Sunday July 26th

This day begins moderate breezes from N.W. at 6 AM the Sawyer and Atlas get under weigh employed getting water on shore at dark the schooners come in to anchor

Monday July 27th

Begins fresh breezes from North with rain the schooners in the harbour the hauls to N.W.

Tuesday July 28th

Come in light winds from N.W. the Atlas and Sawyer went out Middle part fresh breezes the Atlas Sawyer and Pacific come in to anchor ends moderate

Wednesday July 29th

All this day fresh breezes from the Northward with rain and snow all the schooners in the harbour

Thursday July 30th

Come in moderate breezes from West at 6 AM all the schooners got under weigh one head went down the coast for gunies at dark the Atlas come in to anchor ends fresh breezes

Friday July 31st

This day comes in with fresh breezes from West with a snow storm middle part more moderate the Sawyer and Pacific come in from Royal Wharf having left there chains ends the wind N.W.

Saturday August 1st

All this day fresh breezes from N.W. with steady rain all the schooners in the harbour ends

Sunday August 2nd

All the fore part of this day strong breezes from West all the schooners in the harbour ends strong breezes from N.W.

Monday August 3rd

This day begins with a fresh gale from west with snow squalls all the schooners in the harbour ends more moderate
