Comes in with a fresh breeze from N. N. W. pleasant. Middle part a fresh breeze from N. W. pleasant. Latter part the same. Employed in stowing water and other duties. The schooner still absent.

Wednesday Sept 23rd

Comes in fresh breezes from West. W. pleasant. Middle part latter part the same. Employed in various jobs.

Thursday Sept 24th

Comes in with a light breeze from N. W. with snow squalls. Middle part blow fresh latter part more moderate. Bent main top sail new sail.

Friday Sept 25th

Comes in a light breeze from Eastward with snow. Middle part pleasant. Latter part wind S. E. Employed on ship's duty.

Comes in with a fresh breeze pleasant. Middle part squally. Latter more moderate. Employed bending sails and other jobs.

Wednesday Sept 30th

Comes in with a light breeze from the N. W. pleasant. Employed bending sails. Middle and latter part moderate.

Thursday Oct 1st

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the S. with the greatest fall of snow we have had this winter. Middle part fresh breeze from the S. E. Latter part the same toward night pleasant. The schooner came in from the Pacific.
