Tuesday Oct 13th

Come in with a light breeze from the W. pleasant middle part the same latter part calm Employed in various jobs so Ends the Day schooner E. R. Sawyer get under weigh for Mutton Cove

Wednesday 14th

Come in with a light breeze from the W. S. W. pleasant middle part the same latter part breeze fresh from the W. so Ends the Day

Thursday 15th

Come with the wind W. S. W. pleasant at 9 et 10 get under weigh for Hurd's Island middle part fresh breeze spoke schooner R. B. Coleman of Ester Leonden bound for Hurd's Island alert Sawyer Pariffis and Atlas in Company latter part blow strong wind hauls to the S. took all sail but a close reef main top sail fore spencers so Ends the Day

Friday 16th

Come in with the wind from W. S. W. pleasant steering by the wind under close reef main top sail and fore sails and spencers two vessels in sight middle part more moderate latter part the same heading by the wind S. S. W. so Ends the Day at 6

Saturday 17th

Come in with a fresh breeze from the W. S. W. cloudy heading S. S. W. under close reef main top sail fore sail spencers at 8 heading set fit middle part hauls moderate latter a light breeze from the W. S. W. set fore and mizen top sails main sail etc etc

Sunday 18th

Come in with a light breeze from the S. E. with thick weather steering S. S. W. all sail spoke Sawyer and Atlas at 11 et 12 noon at 1 took in all sail close reef main top sail and fore sail at dark took in the fore sail Sawyer and Atlas in sight middle part wind light latter part a moderate breeze from the W. cloudy at 9 et 10 saw Mr Donald J. J. and Hurd's Island steered in for the Sound under double reef top sails fit up fore sail and so Ends the 24 hours

Monday 19th

Come in with a fresh breeze from the S. E. cloudy still steering for the island until 11 et 12 took in sail and luffed off shore under double reef main top sail and fore sail middle part moderate with

rain latter part blows fresh from the S. E. with thick rainy weather more ship a number of times so Ends

Tuesday 20th

Come in with a moderate breeze from the S. E. thick rainy weather ship under close reef main top sail and fore sail heading W. S. W. middle part light air with snow latter part the same spoke Barque alert saw the Sound wind to the South and light could not get in

Wednesday 21st

Come in with a light breeze from the W. S. W. with thick weather toward night clear up saw the rocks alert in Company wind hauls to the W. middle part a strong breeze latter part the same at daylight saw the Island kept off so it got off anchor got up chains and at 11 et 12 came to an anchor in 9 fathoms water pulled sails so Ends
