

Ship Corinthian Laying at Herds Island E D Rogers Master 1851

Thursday 22nd

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the Northward Middle part rain comes our anchor that we kept there East season latter part wind from the Northward with rain so Ends the Day

Friday 23rd

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the W. with thick weather doing nothing on board waiting for good weather there is 1 vessel in this fleet all told middle part light breeze with rain latter part the wind hauls to the Northward with rain so Ends

Saturday 24th

Comes in with a light air from the Eastward with snow hands Employ marring Ship and other duties but blows from the W. latter part the same Employ in various jobs

Sunday 25th

Comes in with a strong breeze from the N. with snow Employ marring Ship at 12 finished 3 Anchors down with two chains 105 fathoms of chain on one and 75 on the other Middle part blow a gale from the W. latter part a fresh breeze from the N. got blubber off from the Shore and other jobs

Monday 26th

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. with snow and rain Employ on various jobs Middle part blowing from the N. W. W. Clear weather latter part Moderate at Meridian wind hauls to the Northward with rain

Tuesday 27th

Comes in with a strong breeze from the N. with rain Employ clearing up between decks schooners all went to the Seaward after blubber Middle part blowing a gale from the N. with rain latter part the same so Ends the Day

Wednesday 28th

Comes in with a moderate breeze from the N. cloudy weather Employ in various jobs Middle part blows heavy from the Northward latter part wind light from the East with rain hoisted in our blubber and steamed it Day Ends with a calm

Thursday 29th

Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. with snow hands Employ in various jobs the schooners still absent to the Seaward Middle part wind light latter part a light breeze from the East pleasant at 4 P.M. started the seals commenced boiling Day Ends with a light air from the N. pleasant

Friday 30th

Comes in with a light air from the Northward pleasant Employ boiling and other jobs schooners still absent at dark finished boiling wind light and baffling Middle part strong breezes from the S. W. latter part moderate pleasant all hands on board so Ends

Saturday 31st

Comes in with a light breeze from the S. W. pleasant Employ stowing down in the run in barrels schooners absent Middle and latter part the same so Ends the Day
