

Ship Corinthian Laying at Herods Island C.D. Bay

Monday Nov 29th 1857

Commenced with calm & clear
at 4 AM light winds E & S
stowing down & trying out
at 10 AM rain at 12 PM
Atlas & Atlantic came in at
has made the quickest trip
that has been made 32 mi
Hatch oil & 10 lbs soap
at 1 PM fresh winds E & S
with rain & snow so ends

Tuesday Nov 30th

Commenced with fresh winds
at 10 AM with squalls of snow
at 1 PM wind rose to
stowing down & trying out
at 1 PM rain at 12 PM
light winds & cloudy so ends

Wednesday Dec 1st

Commenced with light
winds & variables with the
weather at 3 AM snow
sawyer & Colman got away
at 5 AM Atlantic
got underway & trying out
at 7 PM Atlantic came back
took in 14 casks oil from Atlas
at 10 AM winds E & S with rain
& snow at 1 PM cooked down at
5 PM winds hauled to W
with squalls of snow & rain
strong gales to W so ends

Thursday Dec 2nd

Commenced with strong gales
W & S with squalls of snow
at 1 PM more moderate
down oil at 11 PM stowed
works at 1 PM light winds
good weather got a raft of
man shoes at 1 PM light
wind to W with thick snow
weather so ends

at 12 M left Atlantic
Left for Leward

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Friday Dec 3rd 1857

Commenced with fresh winds
cloudy weather, camp trying out
at 2 PM finished our blubber
at 1 PM strong winds N & W
cloudy weather so ends

Saturday Dec 4th

Commenced with strong
winds & thick weather
at 1 PM wind to W got a raft
blubber from the shore at 8
PM the Pacific came in from
Desolation at 1 PM light winds
N & W cloudy weather so ends

Sunday Dec 5th

Commenced with light winds
N & W thick weather at 4 AM
the Atlas got under way for
Saddle Point of E. Coast
for Leward camp stowing down
oil & hoisting water on deck
at 1 PM light winds & variables with
rain took a raft of empty casks
ashore at 2 PM Atlas came in
from Saddle Point 28 casks
blubber at 8 PM strong winds
N & W rain at 1 PM fresh
winds N & W cloudy so ends

Monday Dec 6th

Commenced with moderate
winds N & W cloudy at 5 PM
stowed the works using oil for
the other being cracked at 1 PM
took in 14 casks blubber from Atlas
at 1 PM light winds & variables
so ends

Tuesday Dec 7th

Commenced with light winds & variables
cloudy weather trying out fuel
at 1 PM light winds N & W with
rain at 4 PM finished the
blubber saw a ship to Leward
at 1 PM winds light & with
rain so ends
