Comes in with a fresh breeze from N. and hauls to the W. take in light sails and single reef the top sail tack Ship heading N. by W. on this tack at 6 take in Main sail and fit Middle part blowing fresh double reef for Top sail close reef Mizzen latter part more Moderate set fit and Main sail wind hauls to the S.W. Steering N.W. by W. Lat 32:39 Long 39:50

Sunday Jan 24th

Begins with the wind S.W. pleasant Steering N.W. by W. with top gallant sails set on single reef top sails fit and courses Middle part the same latter part Calm so Ends

Comes in with a light breeze from the E.S.E. pleasant Steering W. by N. all sail set at 6 AM spoke Ship Contest of New York bound to New York Middle part light airs latter part Calm boarded the Contest saenger in sight
