Comes in with a calm pleasant
at 6 a light breeze from the S.W.
steers on W. Contest and sawyer in sight
middle part fresh breezes latter
part moderate steering W. all sail set

the E. pleasant steering W. all sail

all sail set Employed turning up

Comes in fresh breezes from
the E. pleasant steering W. by N.
all sail set middle part wind
hails in a squall at 11 took
in studding sails and light sails
soon after double reef the top
sails furled yet and main sail
latter part took in fore and mizen
top sail at 9 were ship heading
et. saw a sail

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Wednesday Feb 10

Master

Comes in with a moderate breeze
from the S.W. pleasant Employed
aboard the latter part a light breeze from
day of his S.E. pleasant weather
own arrival

Thursday Feb 11

Note Feb 11
took 5 men on board
as passengers who agree
to work their passage
home one man the
Consul put on board
and one man that
appeared after the ship
sailed from table bay

Comes in with a light breeze
from the S.E. pleasant got our
water and sold 80 barrels of oil
middle part light air and calms
latter part a light breeze from
S.E. pleasant at 10 8 M got
under weigh from table bay bound
for New London at 11 passed
Green point so ends the day

Friday Feb 12

Comes in with the wind from the
Northward pleasant steering by the
wind all sail set several in sight
got anchored on the lower side of chain
and got ship ready for sea at sundown
all clear of the land heading N. by E the
wind middle part wind hails
at 11 M. blew fresh double reef the
top sails latter part more moderate
set all sail steering S.W. by E
saw one sail so ends the day

Saturday 13

Comes in with a moderate breeze
from the S.W. pleasant steering
S.W. by N. all sail set middle part
the same latter part a fresh breeze
from the S. pleasant steering
S.W. by N. hands Employed on Ships
duty Lat 31.45 Long 13.00
