Come in with fresh trades pleasant steering S. E. W. all sail set two sail in sight hands Employed on the rigging Middle part fresh trades latter part Moderate steering S. E. W. so Ends the 24 hours one sail in sight Lat 18:30 Long 16:13 E

Sunday Feb 21

Come in with trades pleasant and fresh steering S. E. W. per compass two points variation Employed on the rigging Middle part fresh trades latter part the same at 8 P. M. saw the island of St Helena bearing N. E. by E dist 20 miles traced by the wind steering for it sail set so Ends the Day

Monday Feb 22nd

Begins with fresh trades pleasant steering for the island all sail set got off Starboard anchor off the bows bent chain got already to connect an anchor several sail in sight at 8 P. M. came to an anchor opposite James town in 15 fathoms water perused sails Middle part light trades latter part the same hands on board Employed getting water and other jobs

Tuesday Feb 23rd

Come in with light trade pleasant at 3 P. M. took our anchor and proceeded to sea with all hands on board at dark the island distant 35 miles steering S. E. by E all sail set Middle part light trades so Ends the Day
