Monday February 5th 49

First part strong breeze and cloudy Last part small breeze and clear Course cruising P.M. Sabbath A.M. Lashing the cutting pendants

Tuesday February 6th 49

First part small breeze and clear Last part small breeze and cloudy Course N. E. by South P.M. Broke out the fore hole for a spar to secure the lower part of the pendants to and put a seizing on and one the cooper is making a new line tub for the larboard boat A.M. Fixing the new stichard boat and and set up the main top mast gallant back stays

Wednesday February 7th 49

First part small breeze and clear Middle and Last Calm Course E by South P.M. Making spinnegarn scrub beams Broke out for irons repairing the whaling apparatus Saw jampers a breaching A.M. Took out for the foresail and sprinker and unbutton the fore course and bent the new one and unbutton the sprinker and bent the new one at work on the whaling apparatus and the cooper at work making a line tub cover

Thursday February 8th 1849

First part calm and clear Middle calm and rain Last part small breeze and clear Course E by S P.M. Broke out for bread and water A.M. At work on the whaling apparatus

Friday February 9th 49

First part small breezes and clear Middle strong breeze Last part pleasant gale Course E by S P.M. Rove the main topsail reef tackle and new spars out haller and mister macombs quitted the line A.M. sent in the flyjib boom and lashed it up side of the main mast rigged the poles

Saturday February 10th 49

First part fresh gale accompanied with rain Last part fresh gale Course S by E P.M. Broke out for beef and pork took in the mainst. boat filled the main course double reefed the topsails A.M. hoisted the main course A.M. hoisted the fore topsail at 6 o'clock filled the main course

Sunday February 11th 49

These 24 hours fresh gale gale and squally accompanied with rain Course S by E

Monday February 12th 49

First part fresh breeze gale Last part fresh breezes course S by E P.M. Broke out for sugar A.M. Saw a finback
