First part small breezes and cloudy middle fresh breezes and squally Last part fresh breezes and clear course
P. M. Painted the starboard boat making dead eyes etc. At 5 O'clock raised finbacks A. M. at work on the whaling apparatuses at 8 O'clock took a longer observation by measuring the distance of the moon from the sun

Wednesday February 14th 49

First part small breezes and clear Last part fresh breezes and clear course S by E
P. M. Went down the gaff topmast and topmast stuck a two pieces got one and broke one iron. A. M. Stuck two prospectors saved one one floated with the bulk of an olive tree until the boat got a long side then the bird let go of him and he sank at 8 O'clock took a longer by measuring the distance of the sun from the moon at 9 O'clock raised a school of large sperm whales, and lowered about 10 O'clock

Thursday February 15th 49

First part small breezes and clear Last part fresh breezes and clear course S by E
P. M. Came on board with out success about 2 O'clock having chased them until we lost sight of them A. M. at work on the whaling apparatuses etc.

Friday February 16th 49

There 24 hours fresh breezes and clear course S by E
P. M. at work on the whaling apparatuses

Saturday February 17th 1849

First part fresh breezes and clear weather Last part small breezes and clear course S by E
P. M. Did little doing every one busying himself as best pleased him or remaining idle A. M. took out for water

Sunday February 18th 49

First part small breezes and clear middle small breezes and foggy Last small breezes and clear
P. M. at work on the whaling apparatuses
A. M. at 3 O'clock saw black fish

Monday February 19th 49

First part small breezes and clear middle clear Last part fresh breezes and clear course S by E
P. M. at 6 O'clock saw black fish A. M. at work staving the fore and jib sheets Took a longer by measuring the distance of the sun from the moon

Tuesday February 20th 49

There 24 hours fresh breeze and clear course S by E
P. M. saw blackfish A. M. saw hump backs

Wednesday February 21st 49

First part fresh breezes and clear Last part fresh gales and cloudy course S by E
P. M. Hoisted a line painted the line tub and at work on the apparatuses for whaling
A. M. Doubled reefed the fore and main topmasts and hauled the new jib
