

Bark Cornelia Indian Ocean

March 1st Thursday

First part small breezes and clear last part the same course East
P.M. Unhatched the fore topsail and commenced to mend it at all finished to mending the fore top sail and broke out for lumber to mend the bulwarks

Friday March the 2^d 49

These 24 hours fresh breezes and changeable weather
Course East Wind South

P.M. Sawing out the lumber for repairing the bulwarks broke out for fish and for low lines etc. & Calcock roped the topsails and at six throes out the reef again & placed the main topsail brace pendant in shape to go around the yard to hook the braces to
Lat 32.12 South
Lon 42.48 East

Saturday March 3^d 49

These 24 hours small breezes and clear weather
St by E Variation 2 points Wind S S W
P.M. Repaired the bulwarks quailed a new line
A.M. Broke out for molasses vinegar
Lat 32.09 South

Sunday March 4th 49

These 24 hours small breezes and clear weather
Wind from S W to N E Course from E by S
P.M. Dressed new line and at work on the whaling apparatus etc at all at 7 o'clock saw a beach Took a noon observation by measuring the distance of the sun from the moon also by measuring the distance of the moon from the star aldebaran

On board Ship Isaac Howland sketch of principal events on her voyage commenced June 1845 Sailed from and belonged to N Bedford Arrived at Bayal June 27th at 8 o'clock Left at 6 P.M. Touched at Beano of the Cape Virg Islands July the 9th crossed the line July 22nd Passed near Trinidad Rocks July 31st Arrived at Tristan d Cunha August 9th Left 21st Arrived at Goughs Island Aug 23rd Left the 27th Passed Cape Good Hope Sept 10th Arrived at Amsterdam Oct 24th left 26th 27th got the first whail Arrived at N Zelon Dec 20th Doubled Cape Horn Jan 22nd 1846 Pitcairns Isle Feb 16th Left 17th Arrived at Howee March 23rd Left the 3rd April for the N Arrived at St Francisco 7 Touched at wahoo 4th April at California Aug 29th Left Sept 15th Santa Nov 2nd Kaninta ship Mobile the 10th Left Santa Passafuro and Juan Ferndes Jan 27th Arrived at Chatham Isle one of the Gallapagos 18th Feb Left 23rd Arr. Howee April 3rd 1847 Left Pitcairns Isle Oct 4th Left 5th Arrived at Tolcahuano Dec 15th left 25th Jan 11th 1848 Doubled C Horn Touched at Teri Telfeng March 19th Per namhuco 23rd Crossed the Equator Arrived at New Bedford April 29th 1848 Making a voig of 2 years 10 mo 19 days and eight hours From the time of weighing first anchor untill it was dropped again in the port of N Bedford with 2800 lbs of whale oil 2 hundred of Spirit 18,000 pounds of bone
