

Bark *Cornelia* of New Bedford off Fort Lauphin I C
Friday May 11th 1849

First part of the 24 hours lowering weather last part
small breeze and fine clear weather Tack and tack
P M Tying out oil Saw whales and towed
for them but without success A M Finished
tying out tack in the waist boat and sent out
the larboard and put the old star board boat
out the waist boat again

Saturday May 12th 49

These 24 hours small breeze and clear with
Tack and tack Wind E S E
P M Painted the in side ~~side~~ of the larboard
boat and replaced the ceiling and at work
on the whaling apparatuses at one o'clock
raised and at 4 o'clock lowered for them
but with out success A M stowing down
Saw finbacks

Sunday May 13th 49

First part of the 24 hours small breeze and clear last part
small breeze and showers Wind N E Tack and tack
P M finished stowing down Washed the hid
work A man fell from the main stay and
picked his shoulder on the combings of the fell
back but the wind was slight A M the saw
both nothing doing worthy of remark

Monday May 14th 49

These 24 hours small breeze and calms with very fine
fine weather Between 11 and 12 saw a very handsome whale
P M the sabbath A M Repairing the waist boat
and at work in the rigging

Cornelia of A Bedford off Fort Dauphin I C
Tuesday May 15th 1849

First part of these 24 hours calm last part small
breeze clear weather through the day

P M A M work in the rigging and on
the starboard boat A M at sun rise lowered
and in 10 moments the larboard boat
struck one and lanced another and the
waist boat presently struck the lanced
whale and both whales were alongside at
2 o'clock Sixty barrels



Wednesday May 16th 49

First part of these 24 hours small breeze last
part fresh breeze and clear head yards aback
P M got the body and junk of one whale
aboard and started the tryworks at 7 o'clock
A M hauled the case and come need to
cut in the other whale and cooled down
two o'clock

Thursday May 17th 49

These 24 hours fresh breeze small waves and
calms Head aback sundown Wind South
P M luted the whale except the head
and started the tryworks again at 5 o'clock
A M beared away the jaws and cut up the
junk the tryworks a going

Friday May 18th 49

These 24 hours small breeze and clear weather
wind N
P M luted the remaining case and junk
the tryworks a going A M finished cutting the
junk the tryworks a going
