

Lying at Johanna Bark Cornet

Saturday June 16th 1849

These 24 hours first part squally and
and raining last part fine clear weather.
The Starboard wack ashore on liberty broke
out and stowed down the water and
wood and filled up one scuttle but
broke out for flower painted the
bends on the Starboard side and the
stern and painted her name

Sunday June 17th , 49

These 24 hours fine clear weather

The Starboard wack went ashore on liberty
The "Bark" United States Capt Smith
of Westport sailed to day. When we
were on shore we past three men in
the street that were drumming and
they told us that they were drumming
which they were ~~circumcising~~ circumcising
a boy we also in another place
saw a number of men on top of a
house, drumming accompanied with
singing and were informed that
there was a big man married

Monday June 18th , 49

Fine clear weather these 24 hours

The Starboard wack on shore on liberty
got 4 casks of water from shore

2 boat loads of vegetables such as taro
sweet potatoes, bananas, pineapples and
pumpkins etc. Blacked the bends on
the Starboard side repainted the stern and
her name and commenced to paint her head

Tuesday June 19th 1849

The Starboard wack ashore on liberty
finished painting the Starboard
side of the old bark

Wednesday June 20 , 49

These 24 hours fine weather with a
very few drops of rain

The Starboard wack on liberty
Painted the Starboard side from the
ruil to the capier cleaned the
wheel

Thursday June 21st , 49

A.M. Rain squalls P.M. Strong breezes
The Starboard wack ashore on liberty
broke out the hold and stowed down water
and brought of a small raft of water.
An English Bark came in loaded
with coal

Also a french hump hridote brig
that appears to be a cutter

Friday June 22nd , 49

These 24 hours clear weather except
a few rain squalls but there was
sudden gusts of wind continuing from
1 to 5 moments through the day

Broke out for oil to twirl with the English
bark for coaltar stowed of the fore main and
after hold and painted the inside of
the Starboard keel and covered her bottom.
