

Johanna July 1<sup>st</sup> 1849  
Sabbath The star board wash a shore  
on liberty Painted the heads and wash  
streaks on both sides. Broke out the  
run for soap. Hove down the rigging  
and cleared it for making sail  
for some the cat falls

I now commence on stine  
Mon. July 2<sup>d</sup> 1849  
First part of these 24 hours fresh also  
last part more moderate  
This morning when we called all had  
one man was a missing he was an  
Irish man that went by the name  
of John Anorgin We got leaf from  
shore this morning and tied him up  
to the lash sail and the Capt and mate  
with a boat went on shore to look  
for the missing man but with out  
success the came on board and  
weighed anchor and put to sea  
about 10 O'clock the ship Martha  
and bark Gosnold of new Bedford  
having weighed anchor before us and  
was nearly out of sight

Tuesday July 3<sup>d</sup> 49  
fresh breezes and clear weather  
P.M. Stowed the anchors cables etc  
washed the decks Killed the bullock  
Overtook and spoke the bark Gosnold  
and gamed with her also at work on  
the Gosnold in balancing apparatuses  
All at work on the whale line apparatuses  
and mending the shroving gear

Cornelia of N Bedford off Comoro  
Tuesday July 4<sup>th</sup> 1849  
These 24 hours fresh breeze and clear  
Under the foretopmast stays and ~~to~~ <sup>to</sup> lift it up  
at work on the whale line apparatuses  
and in the rigging The gonold  
has been in company with us  
a part of the day Lying off and  
between the Islands of Gubona  
and Mohilla All ran to getham  
to look for a man that left  
us the night before we sailed but  
he could not be found I was  
afraid that he got drowned  
in attempting to swim a shore  
On arriving we saw one of  
Her Britannic Magistys Schooners  
of war at 12 O'clock we were  
miles from the port again

Thursday July 5<sup>th</sup> 49

P.M. stood along making nearly  
a West course and at 6 O'clock Mohilla  
bark south distant 20 miles and Comoro  
bark N by W distant 30 miles  
A ship lying at anchor on the south  
side of Mohilla saw several down through  
the day Broke out the fore hold and  
got out the fore top rail and mended  
it chell brok out for seiger  
re. sent the jib
