

Bark *Cornelia* of N Bedford at Johanna
Monday September 3rd 1849

These 24 hours fine clear weather with small breeze
Got of a raft of water stowed of the after hold
with water and meat. Got two boat loads
of meat from the bark *Narcissa* of N Bedford
the bark *Manilla* left the port the Starboard
was ashore on liberty.

Tuesday September 4th 49

These 24 hours light breeze and fine clear weather
The Starboard was ashore on liberty.
Got some produce from shore filled the
prolate pan with butter also got some sweet
potatoes and pumpkins and two sacks
of rice. Took of a small raft of water
and stored it in the main hold on the
Starboard side.

Wednesday September 5th 49

Small breezes and fine clear weather
Got to raft a shore and brought off one finished
storing water on the Starboard side and
most of it on the Starboard and stowed the coconuts
in the run and got of some taro.

Thursday September 6th 49

These 24 hours fine clear weather and small breeze
Got of 2 casks of water and stowed it down
all hands on board. Washed the ship
out side and in. Brought of a head
of taro some sweet potatoes and
a bullock and killed him.

Friday September 7th 49

Small breezes and fine clear weather
Starboard was ashore on liberty
got of a bullock.

Cornelia of N Bedford at Island of Johanna
Saturday September 8th 49

These 24 hours fine clear weather and light
The Starboard was ashore on liberty.
Got of a goat and some fowls etc.
At 11 o'clock the ship of from the shore
and at 1 o'clock loosed sails and took
the anchor and got under way and
had a calm and had to tow ship
until 4 AM of the 9th.

Sunday September 9th 49

At 11 o'clock and very light breeze
Lying of to the westward of Johanna
Lashed the anchors on the bow and
stowed the Starboard cable.

Monday September 10th 49

These 24 hours light breeze and
fine clear weather.
At 11 o'clock the Sabbath raised a bark and
spoke her she was the *Bartholomew*
owned of N Bedford Capt. Taher
with one thousand bbls of sperm
oil and 450 of humpback bone oil
into port at sundown we lay
between the Islands of Johanna and
Mohilla At 11 o'clock saw a sail to southward
Anointed the anchors down a breeze.

Tuesday September 12th 49

These 24 hours small breezes and calm.
At 11 o'clock and at 11 o'clock.
