

Back on the off of Bedford in Morgan River
Friday September 28th 1849

These 24 hours small breezes and calms
with fine clear weather
J. M. gained with the bark Marcella of
Bedford and saw a mother bark to
windward supposed her to be the
Alto of Bedford All the mackerel
is in sight this morning

Saturday September 29th 49
These 24 hours small breezes
and fine clear weather

J. M. rigged the sprit sail yard
and lashed it. A sail in sight to
the South East at all setting up
the head rigging

Sunday September 30th 49
These 24 hours calms and small
breezes with fine clear weather
J. M. finished setting up the
head rigging at all the Sabbath
broke out for beef pork and vinegar

Monday October 1st 49
These 24 hours small breezes and calms
with very fine weather Wind from S E to S
J. M. the Sabbath at all the crew is
most by washing

Tuesday Oct 2^d 49
Calms and small breezes with very fine weather
J. M. making line for grafting
straps or at all unbent the fore Lat 18 16 Lat
course mended it and sent it a log again on 42 30 E

Back on the off of Bedford in Morgan River
Wednesday October 3^d 1849

These 24 hours small breezes and fine clear
weather at 4 not current setting to the S
J. M. unbent the gill and mended it
and bent it again at all strapping blocks
and on broke out for water

Thursday October 4th 49
Small breezes and calm at current
setting to the Northward
J. M. strapping blocks or at all
a repairing block straps etc

Friday Oct 5th 49
These 24 hours small breezes and calms
with fine weather Wind S E Current at
all M. mending a block straps
etc at all broke out for the fore topsail
and mended it took the new Starboard
boat from over head and commenced to
repair her

Saturday Oct 6th 49
Small breezes and very fine clear weather
Course S E wind from E to North
J. M. finished repairing the starboard
boat and put her over head. Strapping blocks
at all scraped and slushed the log line etc

Sunday Oct 7th 49
Small breezes and very fine clear weather
J. M. harked the hullworks out
side and in at all the Sabbath
Lat 18 23 South
