Saturday October 27th 49

Fast gales and clear wind South

topsails loosened the main course and

and gaff topsail

Drank out for oil vinegar
molasses

Sunday October 28th 49

First part fresh gales last part moderate
P.M. at work on the whaling apparatus
A.M. the sabbath

Monday October 29th 49

These 24 hours small breezes and calms
P.M. the sabbath, breaking and shaking the
main line broke out water

plates off at the same Lat 21
