

Bark Globe of New Bedford ^{cho} May 27th 51 These 24 hours commenced with moderate breezes and calms arrived at the Presdane at five P.M. and staid on shore that night. The ship was becalmed and could not get to the Presdane. A.M. the Starboard bot started in the ship and succeeded in finding it we got on board the ship at four. Lat by Ob 22.03 S. The men left on the Starboard went on board of the bark and got some water potatoes.

Wednesday May 28th 51 These 24 hours commenced with moderate breezes and fine clear weather. Saw fin backs at the last part fresh gales and fine clear weather raised the sand and at seven the boat came on shore on board and feathered seven turtles putting the hull in order. Steering S.W. wind S.E. sunk on the sea. Lat by Ob 22.10 S.

Thursday May 29th 51 These 24 hours commenced with fresh gales and fine clear weather nothing in sight. P.M. continues strong breezes and fine clear weather. Broke out for water & bark and bark steering N.W. wind S.E.

Friday June 1st 51 These 24 moderate breezes and fine clear weather. Saw fin back wind S by W. P.M. moderate breezes and cloudy nothing in sight wind S.E.

Saturday June 2nd 51 These 24 hours fresh gales and fine clear weather wind South. Saw fin back and bark. P.M. moderate breezes and fine clear weather wind S.E. Steering N by W. Lat by Ob 22.30 S. Lon by Chro 38.40 E.

Sunday June 3rd 51 These 24 hours commenced with moderate breezes and fine clear weather. P.M. first part moderate breezes and fine clear weather. Lat by Ob 22.47 S. Lon by Chro 38.47 E.

Bark Globe of New Bedford Channel Wednesday June 4th 51 These 24 hours commenced with moderate breezes and fine clear weather. Saw black fish. P.M. moderate breezes and fine weather. Broke out for water and flour. Steering E.N.E. wind S.E. Lat by Ob 18.27 S. Lon by Chro 46.03 E.

Thursday June 5th 51 These 24 hours commenced with fresh gales and fine clear weather. nothing in sight wind S.E. Course E.N.E. P.M. more moderate wind S.W. Course E.N.E. Cooper making kids at work on the ground. Lat by Ob 17.30 S. Lon by Chro 41.06 E.

Friday June 6th 51 These 24 hours commenced with fresh gales and fine clear weather raised the sand of Grandenova or St Christopher. Saw fin back and porpoises. P.M. moderate breezes and fine clear weather. Rigging the fore top gallant yard and sent it up again. Cooper making oag winds S.S.W. Course N. Lat by Ob 19.01 S. Lon by Chro 42.45 E.

Saturday June 7th 51 These 24 hours first part fresh gales and fine clear weather wind S.W. Steering N.W. Sent in the gillie and repaired it. P.M. sent it out and sent it saw Cow fish and porpoises. Took bow fish and up porpoises wind S.W. Steering N.W. Broke out for flour. Lat by Ob 15.44 S. Lon by Chro 41.44 E.

Sunday June 8th 51 These 24 first part fresh gales and squalls. Saw manetique on a reef. Saw porpoises and fin backs. P.M. first part fresh gales and squalls. Saw abail to windward. Supposed to take a whaler wind S.W. Steering S.E. Lat by Ob 15.07 S. Lon by Chro 40.40 E.
