foretopmast rigging all sail Lat by Ob 5° 37' N

Tuesday March 23rd 52 these 24 hours fresh gales and some squalls
P.M. macking, sunset wind all round the compass coarses W to W and W by N
A.M. small breezes and calms macking, sunset wind around the
compass coarses W to W Lat by Ob 6° 06' N

Wednesday March 24th 52 these 24 hours small breezes and clear
P.M. wind from S to W coarses W to W macking, sunset A.M.
small breezes and calms with copious showers of rain wind from S to S.W.
macking, sunset all sail Lat by Ob 6° 46' N

Thursday March 25th 52 these 24 hours small breezes and
clear P.M. macking, sunset look out for flowers wind W
A.M. small breezes and equally wind from S to S.W. sailing the main
topmast rounds all sail agree to variety of fresh winds all around Lat by Ob 6° 46' N

Friday March 26th 52 these 24 hours fresh gales and clear
P.M. sailing the foretopmast shrouds wind from S to W to W
A.M. small breezes and calms wind from W to S.E. coarses W to the starboard
and mist that went on shore avoiding S
all sail Lat by Ob

Saturday March 27th 52 these 24 hours small breezes and clear
P.M. sailing the main topmast shrouds cut up the wood and blow it in the
forehold wind from S.W. to S.E. coarses W to A.M. fresh gales and clear weather
wind from east S to S.W. sailing and rattle the main topmast rigging
macking, sunset Lat by Ob

all sail sunset insight Lat by Ob 7° 06' N

Tuesday March 30th 52 these 24 hours small breezes and calms
P.M. sailing and rattle the foretopmast rigging wind
from N.W. to N.E. coarses N. A.M. small breezes and clear wind
N. backing out in the main hold for water all sail Lat by Ob 7° 52' N

Wednesday March 31st 52 these 24 hours fresh gales clear wind
from N to N.E. P.M. coarses N.W. finished backing out water and
stowed of the hold filled with water saw a fin back raised the negroes
A.M. fresh gales and clear weather wind E to E coarses N.W. all out
look out for reef and park macking, sunset and clearing out the hold

Thursday April 1st 52 these 24 hours fresh gales and clear
P.M. macking, sunset wind E to E coarses by the wind A.M.
fresh gales and clear weather macking, sunset wind from N.E. to E to E
sunset insight S of Palawan Lat by Ob 9° 28' N Lon by Chron 120° 05' E

Wednesday April 2nd 52 these 24 hours small breezes and clear
P.M. wind E coarses N.W. all sail out A.M. fresh gales and clear
wind from N.W. to S.E. coarses N.W. look out for land but found it to be with the
