

Wednesday Aug 16th 1883 First part very light airs from the Eastward Middle and latter some Fogal bearing S S E Dist 30 Miles

Thursday Aug 16th First part light airs from the East Middle and latter mostly calm at noon Fogal 15 miles dist bearing S S E. Met end

Friday Aug 17th Commences calm at 4 P.M. a light breeze from S.W. Middle and latter brisk breeze from the South at 11 M. H. lowered a Boat and went on shore at Fogal

Saturday Aug 18th First part light breeze from the S.W. at 4 P.M. came on board and steamed out of the Passage to the North Middle squally with rain latter fresh breeze from West Steered E.S.E.

Sunday Aug 19th First part fresh breeze from the Westward Ship running down between St George and Graciosa at 1 luffed to the wind to the North spoke Bark Elizabeth of West Port Middle and latter strong breeze from the West at daylight kept off and run down to the Eastward of Graciosa and then steered South per compass

Monday Aug 20th 1883 First part fresh breeze from the Westward Middle and latter light breeze from N.W. to S.W. Saw San Michael at Noon St Marie in sight ahead

Tuesday Aug 21st First part light breeze from S.W. Middle and latter light winds from the Westward at daylight St Marie in sight astern

Wednesday Aug 22nd First part gentle breeze from the N. spoke Bark Hamilton New Bedford. A little before sunset saw Spinn Whales and lowered the Boats but too late Middle and latter fresh breeze at 4 part 9 AM saw Spinn Whales 5 Miles off going quick to windward could not come up with them Lat 35-21 N Long 24-48 W

Thursday Aug 23rd First part fresh breeze from the North Middle and latter light airs and calms

Friday Aug 24th First part calm Middle same latter light breeze from N.W.

Saturday Aug 25th First part light airs and calms Saw one Sail Middle same Lat 34-45 N

Sunday Aug 26th First part light and calm Middle same one Sail Lat 34-31 N Watched Scorer in sight Long 22-28 W
