Hilliers

First part light air from
E.S.E. to E. saw two Right Whales
about sunset lowered the Boats but
too late Middle moderate breezes
from the North Latter fresh breezes
from N to N.W. saw Finbacks

Friday 23 Nov

First part strong breezes
from N.W. Middle strong breezes
from N.W. to N. Latter same

N.W. with thick wet weather (No Obs)
