Lat 17° 42' S
Long 4° 40' W

Wednesday 24 April

First part very
strong Grades finished and
bent the Gill - Middle and Latter
same Lat 17° 14' S
Long 4° 41' W

Thursday 25 April

First part strong
Grades and suggested - Middle
and Latter same Lat 18° 29'
Long 3° 58'

Friday April 26

First part strong Grades
and suggested - Middle and
Latter same Lat 18° 39'
Long 4° 10' W

Saturday 27 April 1857

First part strong
Grades - Middle and Latter same
saw one Merchantman Lat 18° 49'
Long 4° 08' W

Sunday 28 April

First part fresh Grades
but a little more moderate set
the Main Sail for the first time
for five days. Saw two Whales
to leeward - Middle and Latter
strong Grades and suggested
Lat 18° 30' S
Long 4° 22' W

Monday 29 April

First part strong
Grades and suggested - Middle
more moderate Latter fresh Grades
Lat 16° 38' S
Long 4° 12' W

Tuesday 30 April

First part moder-
ate Grades saw seven all - Mer-
chantman - Middle and
Latter same saw the Osmani
to leeward Lat 17° 06' S
Long 4° 08' W

Wednesday 1st May

First part fresh
Grades - Middle and Latter same

Thursday 2 May

First part moderate
Grades - Middle and Latter
strong Grades at 7 A.M. started
N. by N. Lat 17° 17' S
Long 4° 17' W
