

Friday 3 May 1857 First part strong
Trades and rugged Middle
and Latter same at 8 AM
Saw St Helena at noon the
Isleona bearing N by W Dist
15 miles

Saturday 4 May First part fresh
Trades at 2 PM tacked of shore
Saw a Three Mastia Schooner
Middle and Latter mostly fresh
Trades then E and land bearing
N by E Dist 45 miles

Sunday 5 May First part fresh
Trades saw one Finback
Middle and Latter quite moderate
- at Trades and fine weather
Lat 17° 06' S

Monday 6 May First part gentle
Trades Middle and Latter same

Tuesday 7 May First part fresh Trades
Middle and Latter same at
11 AM saw a school of small
Whales at noon lowered the
Boat Land just in sight bear-
ing N by E.

Wednesday 8 March 1857 First part fresh
Trades at 1 P.M. got fast to a small
Whale The School then left immedi-
-ly chased till 3 o'clock then came
on board and cut in the Whale
Middle and Latter light Trades
at 8 AM started Fires Lat 17° 06' S

the moon
3 days 20 hours

Thursday 9 May First part light Trades
at 7 P.M. finished hauling Middle
and Latter Trades light saw the
Land Lat 18° 42' S
Long 150° 20' W

Friday 10 May First part light Trades
caught a Porpoise and saw Finbacks
Middle and Latter very light
Trades and fine weather slowed down
the oil line in sight Lat 18° 20' S
bearing E by N 4 N

Saturday 11 May First part light Trades saw
Finbacks Middle and Latter same
the Isleona in sight also saw
Finbacks

Sunday 12 May First part moderate
Trades Middle and Latter same
saw Finbacks plenty the dandel
and one Whale Whisk in sight
to leeward
