

Monday 13 May 1807 First part light
grades and fine weather at 8 P
M Spoke Ship Hunter. Bessa.
New Bedford 1500. Middle and
latter moderate grades at noon
the Island bore E by N 2 N Dist
30 Miles

Tuesday 14 May First part gentle grades
Middle and latter same
at noon the Island bore N
E by N Dist 55 Miles

Wednesday May 15th First part
gentle grades saw one Mer-
chantman broad side that
we called whalers Middle
and latter moderate grades
nothing in sight but the land

Thursday 16 May First part light
grades saw 3 or 4 whalers Middle
and latter same the land
the Ship Hunter and one
Merchant Ship in sight

Friday 17 May First part very
light grades Middle and latter
much the same the land
and the Hunter in sight

Saturday 18 May First part gentle grades
and fine weather Middle same
latter strong grades saw one Sail
Land in sight

Sunday 19 May First part strong grades
Middle same latter very strong
grades and rugged saw Mercha-
ntman at noon the Island
bore N E Dist 10 Miles

Monday 20 May First part very strong
grades Middle and latter same
saw nothing but the Land which bore
at noon West Dist 20 Miles

Tuesday 21 May First part strong grades
and rugged Middle and latter
same

Wednesday 22 May First part fresh grades
but rather moderating Middle
same latter moderate grades same
bearing N W by N

Thursday 23 May First part light grades
at sunset the Island bore S E N
Dist 10 Miles middle and latter
moderate grades saw 3 or 4 whalers
