

Friday May 24th 1857

First part moderate
Grades - Middle and latter much
the same

Saturday 25 May

First part brisk Grades
the Land in sight bearing S W
Middle and latter fresh Grades
saw many Finbacks

Sunday 26 May

First part fresh Grades
Land in sight to the S W saw
Finbacks Middle and latter
fresh Grades saw Finbacks

Monday 27 May

First part strong
Grades Middle and latter same
at 10 A M came to anchor at
St Helena

Tuesday 28 June

at 10 A M weighed
anchor and went to sea

Wednesday 7 June

First part light wind,
heaving to the S W Middle and
latter fresh Grades at 9 A M tacke
to the Eastward

Thursday 8 June

First part fresh Grades
middle same at daylight the
Island bore N W Dist 21 Miles
saw several merchantmen

Sunday 9 June 1857

First part fresh Grades
Ship heading E by S at 5 P M tacke
Ship and headed S by W Middle and
latter strong Grades saw Finbacks
Lat 11° 35' N
Long 4° 58' W

Monday 10 June

First part fresh Grades
from South to S S W Middle and
latter moderate Grades from S E by S
Lat 17° 43' N

Tuesday 11 June

First part light air and
calm Middle and latter light breeze
from the S W Ship by the wind to
the S Eastward
Lat 18° 00' N
Long 4° 23' W

Wednesday 12 June

First part fresh breeze
from S by W and squally Middle
and latter strong Grades and squally
saw two merchantmen Lat 17° 57' N
Long 2° 52' W

Thursday 13 June

First part strong Grades and
squally saw one merchantman Middle
and latter same Spoke Ship Hunter

Friday 14 June

First part strong Grades
Hunter in sight Middle and latter
more moderate got 82 Gall Malasses
from the Hunter
Lat 17° 04' N
Long 1° 05' W
