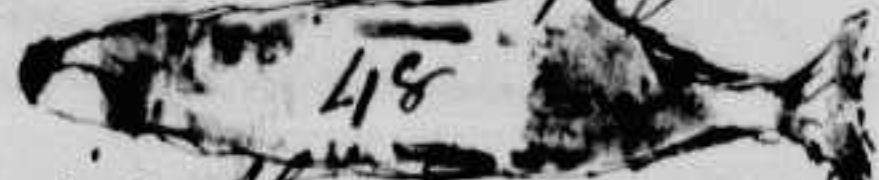


Sunday 4 Aug 1867

First part Two Boats Cruising
and the other Boats crew on board stowing
oil. Half past 2 P.M. struck a Whale
 at 5 took him alongside
in the morning commenced cutting

Monday 5 Aug

First part all hands employed
on board cutting up blubber and other
work Latter all hands employed boiling
and stowing down oil

Tuesday 6 Aug

First part boiling and Two Boats
off Cruising saw no Whales at 7 P.M. finish
-ed boiling Latter Three Boats Cruising
but saw no Whales

Wednesday 7 Aug

First part Three Boats Cruising
saw no Whales Latter all the Boats off
saw no Whales

Thursday Aug 8

First part all the Boats
off saw one Whale going quick
to the N. Latter all the Boats off and
saw one Whale

Friday 9 Aug

First part all hands on board
employed stowing oil Latter all the
Boats off Cruising saw no Whales

Saturday 10 Aug

First part all the Boats off
but saw no Whales Latter all the Boats
off saw 4 Whales but caught none

Sunday 11 Aug 1867

First part all the Boats of but
got no Whales Latter got the anchor and
made sail and sent Two Boats off
thus End Ship beating to windward

Monday 12 Aug

First part Two Boats off
Cruising at 3 P.M. came to anchor
in 12 fathoms water saw 4 Whales all
going quick to the N. Latter all the Boats
off saw no Whales

Tuesday 13 Aug

First part all the Boats off saw one
Whale going quick to the N. at 5 P.M. was board
by an English Gun Boat Latter all the
Boats Cruising saw no Whales

Wednesday 14 Aug

First part all the Boats
Cruising saw no Whales Latter Two
Boats Cruising the others employed
on board breaking out meat and
filling the Cask with Pickle that had
boiled out. Saw no Whales

Thursday 15 Aug
of 6 out P
9 1/2 Blb

First part Two Boats Cruising
saw no Whales Latter all the Boats Cruis-
ing saw one Whale

Friday 16 Aug

First part all the Boats Cruising
saw one Whale Latter all the Boats off saw no
Whales

Saturday 17 Aug

First part all the Boats off saw no
Whales Latter went on shore at Spikes Head
and bot 14 Goats
