

Sunday 18 Aug 1867

First part on shore with one Boat, lowered the other two once for Whales without success at 5 PM got on board from the shore at 6 AM weighed Anchor headed off shore with light airs and calms thus Enders Land in sight about 5 leagues

Monday 19 Aug

First part mostly calm at sunset the land in sight Middle very light airs and calms latter light breezes from S. to S.E. Ship by the wind to the S. Westward, Empe loyed washing ship Lat 6° 54 S Long 11° 30 E.

Tuesday 20 Aug

First part light airs from S S E to S S W Ship heading to the Westward Middle mostly calm latter light breezes from S E. Ship by the wind to the S W Lat 7° 13 S Long 11° 17 E.

Wednesday 21 Aug

First part light airs from S S W and S W Middle and latter light airs from the S W and calms Saw an English Brig steaming by the wind to the S Eastward Lat 7° 18 S Long 10° 40 E.

Thursday 22 Aug

First part light breezes from S S W to S W Middle very light-airs from S W to W S W latter light breezes from the South and Sumpers no Obs

Friday 23 Aug 1867

First part light breezes from the South Middle light-airs and calm latter light-airs from S W and S W by S Lat 6° 50 S Long 10° 24 E.

Saturday 24 Aug

First part light breezes from S W by S Middle and latter quite strong breezes from S W by S Lat 6° 51 S Long 8° 14 E.

Sunday 25 Aug

First part strong breezes from S W by S Middle much the same latter fresh breezes from South Lat 7° 00 S Long 7° 58 E.

Monday 26 Aug

First part fresh breezes from South Middle and latter same Lat 7° 25 S Long 7° 08 E.

Tuesday 27 Aug

First part strong breezes from the South Middle and latter moderate breezes from South to S W. Ship on starboard tack Lat 7° 43 S Long 8° 10 E.

Wednesday 28 Aug

First part light breezes from S S W with a heavy swell Middle same latter calm Lat 7° 54 S Long 8° 39 E.

Thursday 29 Aug

First part calm Middle and latter same Lat 7° 50 S Long 8° 51 E.
