First part mostly Calm
Middle and latter light breezes from
West N.W. to S.W.

□ First part light airs from
the Westward Middle and latter
very light airs from N.W. to S.W.

First part light airs from

First part very light

by the wind to the Westward

gentle breezes from S.W. to S. by E.
