

Sunday 20 Oct. 1857

First part strong breeze
from S E and S E by E. Middle and
latter strong breeze from S E by E
to E by S. Lat 26-28 S.
Long 8-28 W.

Monday 21 Oct.

First part strong winds
from E by S Middle and latter
brisk breeze from the East.
Lat 27-40 S.
Long 7-30 W.

Tuesday 22 Oct.

First part fresh breeze
from the Eastward Middle and
latter light breeze from E to N. N.
& watch employed repairing main
sail. Lat 28-51 S.
Long 7-05 W.

Wednesday 23 Oct.

First part light breeze
from N. N. E to N. N. W. Middle and
latter much the same.
Lat.

Thursday 24 Oct.

First part light breeze
N to N. W. Repaired fly gill
middle and latter wind the same with
a little rain. Lat 30-30 S.
Long 6-40 W.

Friday 25 Oct.

First part commences with light
breeze from the N. with sun rain at
5 P. M. the wind shifted to S. S. W. and
breezing on Middle quite moderate
with sun rain latter winds light and
variable weather thick and rainy

Saturday Oct. 26th 1857

First part moderate
breeze from West to South and sun squ-
alls at 3 A. M. a gale of wind from the
South latter heavy Gale from the South
Lat 31-00 S.

Sunday Oct. 27

First part heavy Gale from
the South Middle same at 8 A. M.
wore ship to the Eastward latter
strong Gale but rather moderating
Lat 30-51 S.
Long 6-25 W.

Monday Oct. 28

First part strong Gale
from the South Middle more mod-
erate latter strong breeze from
S E ship by the wind to the Eastward
Lat 30-13 S.
Long 5-29 W.

Tuesday Oct. 29

First part strong breeze
from South saw two Merchant
Barks by the wind to the Eastward
Middle and latter moderate breeze
from S to S E ship by the wind to
the Eastward sent down main
top sail to repair. Lat 29-29 S.
Long 5-10 W.

Wednesday 30 Oct.

First part light breeze from
the South and Eastward finished
and bent main top sail Middle
and latter fresh breeze from
S E ship on Larboard tack to the
S. W. Lat 30-13 S.
Long 5-22 W.
