First part strong
breezes from S & Middle same
Latter strong breezes from E & S
E by S. Saw Hinbacks Lat 31-21 S
Long 5-23 W

Friday 1 Nov

First part fresh breezes
from E by S. Middle same Latter-
moderate breezes from E to NE with
fine weather Saw Hinbacks Lat 32-40 S
Long 4-16 W

Saturday 2 Nov

First part moderate breezes
from N.E. Middle and Latter same
Lat 33-42 S
Long 4-04 W

Sunday 3 Nov

First part gentle breezes
from the N.E. and fine weather
Middle same Latter strong breezes
from the N.E. saw nothing but
Birds Lat 34-50 S.
Long 4-20 W

Monday 4 Nov

First part strong winds
from the N.E. at 1 P.M. steamer
J & E by S. at 2 P.M. raised a sail
afternoon also saw one Hinback
at 7 spoke the Brig Polly bound for
Alga Bay Middle and Latter fresh
breezes from the N. Easterly
Lat 34-50 S.
Long 2-54 W.

Tuesday 5 Nov 1867

First part fresh breezes
from the North at 4 P.M. raised a sail
on weather beam Middle and Latter
moderate breezes from the North and
fine weather saw two Merchantman
Lat 34-48 S
Long 1-30 W

Wednesday 6 Nov

First part light winds
from the North and pleasant Middle
same Latter strong breezes from the
North saw several Hinbacks
Lat 34-38 S
Long 1-32 W

Thursday 7 Nov

First part strong breezes
from the North Middle and Latter
same at 8 A.M. kept off. S & E by E.
Lat 34-21 S
Long

Friday 8 Nov

First part strong winds
from N. to N.W. with thick wet
weather - Middle more moderate Latter
strong breezes from N.W. Ships course
S. & E by E. saw Hinbacks Lat 34-25 S
Long 1-38 E.

Saturday 9 Nov

First part strong winds
from N.W. strong gales from N to
S.W. ships steering S & E by E. at 3 A.M.
took in fore top sail and luffed to the
wind it blowing heavy in squalls
Latter a little more moderate at 7 A.M.
fore top sail area steered E.S.E.
Lat 34-02 S.
Long 3-18 E.
