

Friday 22 - Nov 1857

First part light breeze from the N.E. at 2 P.M. saw a Right Whale at 3 lowered Boats and chased but could not strike Middle same latter fresh winds from the South saw one Bark Lat 36-17 S. Long 4-53 E.

Saturday 23 - Nov

First part strong breeze from N.E. saw a Bark steering for Cape Horn Middle moderate at 3 A.M. the shifted to the S.W. in a Squall and blowed strong both in fore top sail latter fresh gales from S.W. to South saw one ship steering to the S.E. Lat 35-51 S. Long 4-50 E.

Sunday 24 - Nov

First part fresh Gales from the South Middle and latter moderate winds from S to E.S.E. Lat 35-34 S. Long 5-11 E.

Monday 25 - Nov

First part light breeze from S.E. to E.S.E. Middle and latter light winds from East to N. at 9 A.M. saw a Right Whale going back to N.E. lowered the Boats but did not get near him Lat 35-34 S. Long 4-24 E.

Tuesday 26 - Nov

First part fresh breeze from the N. at 5 P.M. saw two Right Whales lowered and chased until dark but could not get near them

Middle and latter fresh breeze from N.W. by N. and N.W. saw nothing Lat 35-40 S. Long 5-58 E.

Wednesday 27 - Nov

First part fresh breeze from the N.W. at 4 P.M. saw a Right Whale going very quick to windward lowered without success Middle and latter fresh breeze from the N.W. Lat 35-37 S. Long 3-45 E.

Thursday 28 - Nov

First part fresh breeze from N.E. at sunset saw a Whale sporting 4 miles to windward could not ascertain what it was Middle strong wind from N.E. and some squally latter fresh Gales from N.W. and N. and blowing on Mercian fished fore top sail Lat 36-38 S. Long

Friday 29 - Nov

First part heavy Gales from the N. with rain at 6 P.M. wind shifted to S.W. and blowed heavy in squalls Middle moderating at 7 A.M. got some sail on the ship latter strong winds from N.W. to S.W. Lat 35-24 S. Long 3-08 E.

Saturday 30 - Nov

First part strong winds from N.W. to N.E. Middle same latter strong breeze from N.W. to W. saw one Hinback Lat 33-55 S. Long 4-30 E.
