Lat 31-40 S
Long 8-14 E.

First part light airs from
S. S. W. to W. S. W. Middle light breezes
from the Westward and Calms latter
fresh breezes from N. W. Lat 32-25 S
Long 8-36 E.

Saturday 14 Dec

First part commences with
strong breezes from the N. W. at 5 P. M.
strong Gale with heavy squalls and rain
Ship under close reef Main Top-sail and
Fore-spruce at 4 P. M. & wind shifted to
W. and blowed heavy through the
Night latter strong Gale from
S. W. Lat 32-21 S
Long 7-5 E.

Sunday 15 Dec

First part strong Gale
from S. W. but rather moderating
at 5 P. M. set close reefed Fore Top
Sail to steady the Ship Middle
quite moderate breezes from
the S. W. latter light breezes from
the South Lat 32-18 S
Long 9-40 E.

Monday 16 Dec

First part light breezes
from the South Middle and
latter same Lat 32-29 S
Long 9-30 E.

Tuesday 17 Dec 1867

First part light airs from the
South Middle and latter much the
same Lat 32-38 S
Long 8-54 E.

Wednesday 18 Dec

First part gentle breezes
from S. S. W. Middle and latter
moderate breezes from S. S. E. to S. S. W.
Ship's course N. E. W. Lat 32-40 S
Long 7-11 E.

Thursday 19 Dec

First part gentle breezes
S. S. W. Middle and latter light breezes
from the South Lat 32-48 S
Long 5-34 E.

Friday 20 Dec

First part light breezes from
the South Middle and latter light
airs from S. to E. latter light 33-08 S
Long 3-59 E.

Saturday 21 Dec

First part light airs
from the Eastward Ship steering to
the Westward Middle mostly Calm
latter brisk breezes from N. E. W. to
N. W. Lat 33-14 S
Long 3-25 E.

Sunday 22 Dec

First part fresh breezes
from N. W. and N. by N. Ship by the
wind to the S. Westward Middle same
latter fresh breezes from the N. W. and
thick weather Ship on Starboard tack
to the S. Westward Middle Lat 34-10 S
Saw one Merchant Ship Long 2-05 E.
Steaming to the S. E.
