Sunday 5 Jan

First part light airs and calms Middle mostly calm latter gentle breeze from S by E.
Lat $31^{\circ} 20' S$
Long $00^{\circ} 33' E$

Monday 6 Jan

First part strong breeze from the South Middle and latter the same ships steering E by N
Lat $29^{\circ} 59' S$
Long $3^{\circ} 02' E$

Tuesday 7 Jan

First part strong breeze from S to S.W. steering to the S.E. Middle same latter moderate breeze from S to S.E.
Lat $30^{\circ} 00' S$
Long $5^{\circ} 13' E$

Wednesday 8 Jan

First part light breeze from the South Middle and latter light breeze from S.E. with a heavy swell
Lat $30^{\circ} 15' S$
Long $5^{\circ} 27' E$

Thursday 9 Jan

First part light airs from the S.E. Middle and latter moderate breeze from S.E. and S.W.
Lat $29^{\circ} 52' S$
Long $6^{\circ} 00' E$

Friday 10 Jan 1868

First part gentle breeze from S.E. and S.W. Middle and latter light winds from the South saw a Merchant ship steering to the S.W. Watch employed repairing Main topsail
Lat $29^{\circ} 22' S$
Long $6^{\circ} 45' E$

Saturday 11 Jan

First part light breeze from the South Middle and latter strong breeze from S.E. to S. saw two merchantmen
Lat $28^{\circ} 41' S$
Long $7^{\circ} 38' E$

Sunday 12 Jan

First part strong breeze from the South saw two merchantmen Middle and latter same
Lat $27^{\circ} 24' S$
Long $9^{\circ} 28' E$

Monday 13 Jan

All these 24 hours strong winds from the South and rugga saw nothing
Lat $26^{\circ} 53' S$
Long $10^{\circ} 36' E$

Tuesday 14 Jan

First part strong breeze from the South Middle and latter same
Lat $26^{\circ} 38' S$
Long $10^{\circ} 10' E$

Wednesday 15 Jan

First part fresh breeze from the South Middle and latter much the same Watch employed repairing Main sail
Lat $25^{\circ} 49' S$
Long $11^{\circ} 35' E$
