

Thursday 3 - Mar 1868
First part very light breeze and calm Middle and latter light breeze Ships course N.W. Lat 19° 49' S Long 7° 10' E.

Wednesday 4 - March
First part light breeze. Steered N.W. Middle and latter gentle breeze from S to S.E. No Obs

Thursday 5 - March
First part gentle breeze Ships course N.W. Middle and latter brisk breeze Lat 18° 46' S Long 3° 12' E.

Friday 6 - March
First part fresh breeze Ships course N.W. Middle and latter moderate breeze and fine weather Lat 17° 58' S Long 1° 28' E.

Saturday 7 - March
First part gentle breeze Middle and latter same course N.W. Lat 17° 30' S Long 0° 21' W.

Sunday 8 - March
First part gentle breeze Ships course N.W. at sunset Shortened sail and lay about through the night latter fresh breeze Steered N.W. by N. Lat 18° 59' S Long 1° 22' W.

Monday 9 - March 1868
First part fresh breeze Ships course N.W. by N. Middle and latter same ship steering N.W. and N.W. by N. Lat 17° 00' S Long 3° 24' W.

Thursday 10 - March
First part strong breeze Middle and latter same Lat 17° 14' S Long 4° 32' W.

Wednesday 11 - March
First part strong breeze Middle and latter same with thick squally weather No Obs.

Thursday 12 - March
First part strong breeze and squally at 4 P.M. saw St Helena bearing N. by E Dist about 25 miles Middle and latter strong breeze saw nothing but St Helena Lat 16° 18' S

Friday 13 - March
First part strong breeze and sun squally Middle and latter fresh breeze and showery

Saturday - March 14
First part fresh breeze and thick rainy weather Middle same latter fresh breeze Lat 18° 44' S Long 5° 14' W.

Sunday 15 - March
First part fresh breeze at 5 P.M. spoke Bank Osmanly Fish New Bedford so all told Middle strong breeze and squally Lat 18° 30' S Long 5° 14' W.
