Saturday 11 April 1868

First part moderate
Grades from S by E and S. Two sail in
sight. Watch employed repairing
Spanker - Middle and latter light.
Variable airs and Calms with sun
rain several sail in sight. No obs

Sunday 12 April

First part light variable
airs and Calms with sun rain
Middle and latter mostly calm
or very light airs from the North
several sail in sight. Lat 00° 01' S
Long 21° 53' W

Monday 13 April

First part calm Middle
and latter very light airs and Calms
with sun rain - No obs

Tuesday 14 April

First part very light very
- able airs and Calms. Saw Blackfish
and took two. a number of sail in
sight. Middle and latter mostly calm
saw about 20 ships and Banks

Lat 00° 37' N
Long 21° 40' W

Wednesday 15 April

First part Mostly
calm saw Blackfish and took
two. Middle light airs from N to
W with a little rain latter light
airs from the North and Calms
saw several sail. Lat 00° 59' N
