First part light airs from
the N. Westward - Middle the same
latter gentle breezes from N.W. -
with squalls of rain saw several
sail

Saturday 18 April

First part light winds
from the North and squally
Middle and latter very squally
with much rain water when
any all round the compass
many sail seen No obs

Sunday 19 April

First part light airs
from N. to W. with much rain
Middle and latter very light airs
from the N. Westward. Several
sail seen

Monday 20 April

First part light breezes
N.W. to N.W. Middle and
latter light airs from N.W. to
S.W. and calms saw several
sail

Tuesday 21 April 1858

First part very light
airs from N.W. to N.W. and calms
Middle and latter gentle breezes from
N. to N.E. Ship on Western tack
saw several sail

Wednesday 22 April

First part light
breezes from N.W. Middle and
latter gentle breezes from N.W.
saw several sail bound South

Lat 4-00 N
Long 24-08 W

Thursday 23 April

First part light airs
from N.W. Middle and latter
the breezes from N.W. and N.E. by N
saw 7 sail

Lat 4-39 N
Long 24-34 W

Friday 24 April

First part gentle breeze
from N.E. by N and N.E. Middle and
latter light breezes from N.W.
saw one sail

Lat 5-21 N
Long 25-55 W

Saturday 25 April

First part light breeze
from N.W. and N.E. by N. Middle
and latter some ship by the wind to the
N.W.

Lat 6-02 N
Long 26-19 W

Sunday 26 April

First part light breezes from
N.E. by N and N.E. Middle same
latter very light breezes from N.E.
one sail in sight
