First part strong breeze from the South. Saw a Whaling Schooner steering to the Westward also saw Blackfish. Middle same. Latter very strong winds from the South and rugged Steamer S.S.P.

First part strong wind from the South and rugged Ship. Course S.E. Middle and latter same. Saw a large English Ship steering to S.E.

Monday 15 June

First part strong breeze from S. to S.W. Ship by the wind on Starboard tack saw a Merchant Brig steering to the Eastward. Middle and latter light winds from S.W. to W. with showers of rain.

Tuesday 16 June

First part light airs from S.W. to S.E. and Calms. Middle and latter mostly Calm.

Wednesday 17 June

First part Calm. Middle much the same. Latter gentle breeze from the N.E. Took in Larboard Boat to repair.

Thursday 18 June 1858

First part fresh breeze from N.E. and S.E. finished repairs and put out the Larboard Boat.

Middle and latter moderate breeze from the N. Eastward with some rain. Saw a Brig steering to the N.W.

First part moderate breeze from the N.E. Middle and latter light breeze from N.E. to E.
